Academic merit will be determined according to the applicant's cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) for the proceeding years.</p> <p>The Scholarship must be taken up in the year in which it is offered; acceptance of the scholarship offer cannot be deferred. If a student declines the scholarship offer, the scholarship will be offered to the next eligible student.</p>	

**2017 Internship Project**

From 2005 Professor Graeme Hugo published on migration from both a national and state perspective. This year the research project is an analysis of data from the Continuous Survey of Australia's Migrants (CSAM). The focus is on both skilled and other migrants and will analyse South Australia's performance in select visa classes vs at the national level and to report on the employment outcomes according to visa types and migrant profile (occupation group, English language, country of origin), including employment outcomes of the partners of primary applicants.

**The internship project will involve:**

1. A review of Professor Hugo's original work in this area;
2. Analysis of data sets in Microsoft EXCEL;
3. Reporting and updating of South Australia's performance against national trends;
4. Providing recommendations;
